ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Honours Course

A student may be admitted to **B.A/B.Sc Honours Course** after passing the **Higher Secondary Examination** conducted by the **West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education** or examinations conducted by **Indian School Certificate (ISC)** or **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)** or any Other Board recognized as equivalent provided he/she has passed in at least **four subjects with English as Compulsory Subject and excluding EVS**.

Provided that a candidate who has obtained -

(a) 55% marks in the aggregate,

<u>OR</u>

(b) 50% in the aggregate with 60% marks in a subject

in the last qualifying Examination shall be eligible to apply for Honours Program in that subject. Admission shall however be on merit and availability of seats. Provided that for SC/ST Candidates- the minimum marks for eligibility shall be as per Rules of the State Government.

Program Course

A student may be admitted to **B.A/B.Sc Program Course** after passing the **Higher Secondary Examination** conducted by the **West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education** or examinations conducted by **Indian School Certificate (ISC)** or **Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE)** or any Other Board recognized as equivalent provided he/she has passed in at least **four subjects with English as Compulsory Subject and excluding EVS**.

Higher Secondary (Vocational) Course [X+2 levels] students are only eligible for admission in B.A. Program and B.Sc. Program Courses.

Admission to all Program Courses will also be based strictly on merit and availability of seats. Merit shall be calculated as per the following norms:

General Criteria

- 1 It may be noted that in matter of eligibility 49.5% and above shall be equal to 50%; 54.5% and above shall be equal to 55%; and 59.5% marks and above shall be equal to 60%.
- With regard to SC/ST candidates, the minimum marks of eligibility shall be as per rules of the State Government. An SC/ST candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination, qualifying marks not lower by more than 25% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category.
- 3 With regard to OBC-A/OBC-B candidates, the minimum marks of eligibility shall be as per rules of the State Government. An OBC-A/OBC-B candidate getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination, qualifying marks not lower by more than 10% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the general category.
- 4 As per the rules of the State Government SC/ST candidates migrating from other states will be treated as general candidates.
- For admission to the Under Graduate Course there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary Examination and the year of admission to Under Graduate Course of study. (Students passing H.S. in the years 2020, 2021, and 2022 are eligible.)
- 6 Candidates may note that the admission to any Course is provisional. If a candidate fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria laid down by the University of North Bengal, the admission shall stand cancelled at any stage.
- Those students who have credentials in sports and games shall be given due weightage in the admission to UG Courses. Those sports and games shall be considered for weightage which are affiliated to Sports Board, University of North Bengal.
 - 7.i The following sports and games shall be considered for weightage:

i.aAthletics (Men and Women)i.fKho-Kho (Men and Women)i.bBadminton (Men and Women)i.gKabaddi (Men and women)i.cCricket (Men)i.hTable Tennis (Men and women)

i.d Football (Men) i.i Volleyball (Men)

i.e Handball (Men and Women)

7.ii The categories of students who shall be considered for such weightage are as follows:

- ii.a Position Holder at State Level Competition;
- ii.b Participation at National level Competition;
- ii.C Position Holder at National Level Competition;
- ii.d Participation at International level Competition; and
- ii.e Position Holder at International level Competition.

NOTE: Weightage shall be given to students if he/she has participated or held position at International Level Competition in any games and sports.

Important Note

- For candidates under the SC/ST category, SC/ST certificates (valid for West Bengal) must be obtained from the competent authority in the name of the candidate.
- For candidates under the Permanent Disabled Reserved Category, Permanent Disability Certificate must be obtained from the Civil Surgeon/District Medical Officer.
- Attested copies of Certificates are required to be produced at the time of admission.
- At the time of enrolment, a candidate has to submit two copies of recent unattested stamp size (4.6 cm x 4.6 cm) photographs and the original Mark-sheet.
- Candidates from boards other than WBCHSE (any examining body outside the West Bengal) must submit a Migration Certificate from the competent authority.
- All subsequent Notifications, Counselling Schedules, Admission Instructions, Merit Panel, etc. will be uploaded on the College Website and put up in the College Notice Board.
- Contact Office of the Principal for any further query, such as, admission on transfer, method of computation of SGPA & CGPA, rules regarding reassessment & scrutiny, disciplinary rules during examination, provisional result & Grade Card, etc.

MERIT SCORE CALCULATION

Honours Course

Merit = [Marks obtained in English + Marks obtained in the subject opted for Honours + best marks of other two subjects (Excluding EVS, the subject opted for Honours and English)] /4.

If the Student does not have the specific subject opted for Honours in his/her previous Course, the procedure for Merit Calculation will be as follows,

Merit = [Marks obtained in English + Marks in three other best of subjects (excluding EVS and English)] / 4.

Program Course

Merit = [Marks obtained in English+ Marks in three other best of subjects (excluding EVS and English)]/4.
